### **Nursing Staff Updates & Reminders:**

 Please be advised that one of our survey questions has been adjusted in regards to travel to a quarantine state. The definition of travelling to another state means that you have been in that state for at least 24 hours. This does not mean that you were passing through a state or there for less than 24 hours. There are several long weekends



- coming up, and should you choose to travel to a quarantine state for a vacation or visit of longer than 24 hours, all quarantine restrictions must be followed, and the response to that question (8) would be "yes." This will result in non-certification.
- Please be aware that the district will monitor the symptoms of all staff and students, regardless of cohort (hybrid or virtual) through the use of our daily screener, Qualtrics. This is a process coming from the Department of Health and the Department of Education. Should a staff member or student report symptoms, respectful, individual inquiries may be made by our medical staff. If the survey is not completed, you will receive a phone call.

**Free Lunch Program:** All students will be given a free lunch per the USDA guidance. Students do not need to sign up for this service, it has been mandated that all students will receive a grab and go lunch. This will be distributed at dismissal times.

- Per the USDA, free meals are being given to all children during the fall, in an effort to ensure that regardless of situation, all children have access to meals. See information <a href="here">here</a>.
