

8th Grade School Supplies 2020 - 2021:

SEE "SUPPLIES BY SUBJECT" BELOW FOR INFORMATION BY SUBJECT

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **ONE pencil case is needed** to hold the supply requirements for ELA, science, math, and social science.
- No need to duplicate supplies that are carried together in one pencil case. For example, the 1 calculator fulfills the requirement of a calculator for Science and Math.
- A calculator must fit in and be carried in the pencil case with other loose items.
- Do not overdo the supplies to be carried in the pencil case.

***NOTE on BINDERS:**

- The lockers have a **maximum depth of 10.75 inches (27.5 cm)**.
- Do not purchase binders that exceed this measurement **because the lockers will not close** and personal belongings will not be secure.
- Some STAPLES binders do not fit. Please check before purchasing.
- Different colors for each subject is an effective organizational tool for many students.

To be replenished/replaced throughout the year:

Check supplies at the end of each marking period

- pencils (lead and erasers)
- pens
- loose leaf paper
- dry erase markers/highlighters
- damaged binders
- lost or damaged calculators
- index cards
- damaged binders and/or folders

**** NOTE on CALCULATORS:**

- Calculators are used in Science **and** Math.
- **Scientific** calculators have an exponential function: \wedge (i.e. the TI-30, TI-34, or equivalent).
- **Graphing** calculators are expensive, but the high school encourages using them and they are the calculator that must be used on the ALGEBRA 1 NJSLA
- Write full name in **permanent marker** on the BODY of the calculator, **not the lid**.
- A student's calculator should **be able to fit** in and ALWAYS stay in the pencil case for ELA, science, math, and social science.

NOTE ON DUPLICATE SUPPLIES:

- Your schedule may affect how you organize and share supplies across multiple classes
- For example, colored pencils are listed as a requirement for 4 different classes. That does not mean 4 packs of colored pencils are required. If you carry one pencil case for all your classes, you would only need one set of colored pencils. If you keep a separate pencil case for Unified Arts you would need 2 sets.
- Binders, on the other hand, should not be shared

SUPPLIES BY SUBJECT:

General Supplies:

- Loose leaf paper (put a little in **each** binder and **replenish regularly**)
- pencil(s) including erasers and/or lead
- Small pencil sharpener
- pen(s)
- (1) pencil case large enough to hold loose supplies including a calculator
- Earbuds or headphones

ELA:

- (3) 3" X 3" post-it notes, any color
- (3) highlighters (**green, pink, yellow**)

Science:

- Composition notebook - 100 Sheets (or 200 pages)
- Highlighters (multiple colors)
- Colored pencils
- Scientific or graphing calculator **
- **Metric ruler**

Math:

- 2 inch D-ring OR 3 inch O-ring 3-ring binder *
- (7) divider tabs to be labeled as indicated in class
- 2 dry erase markers in BOLD colors and with **thin tips**
- scientific or graphing calculator **
- colored pen (not black or blue)
- small straight-edge (6 inch ruler or small protractor)

Social

Studies:

- 1/2 inch 3-ring binder *
- separate folder (to leave in locker or home) for when we clean out binders
- (1) thin black Sharpie
- Colored pencils/markers

- 1 composition book
- 2 different color highlights
